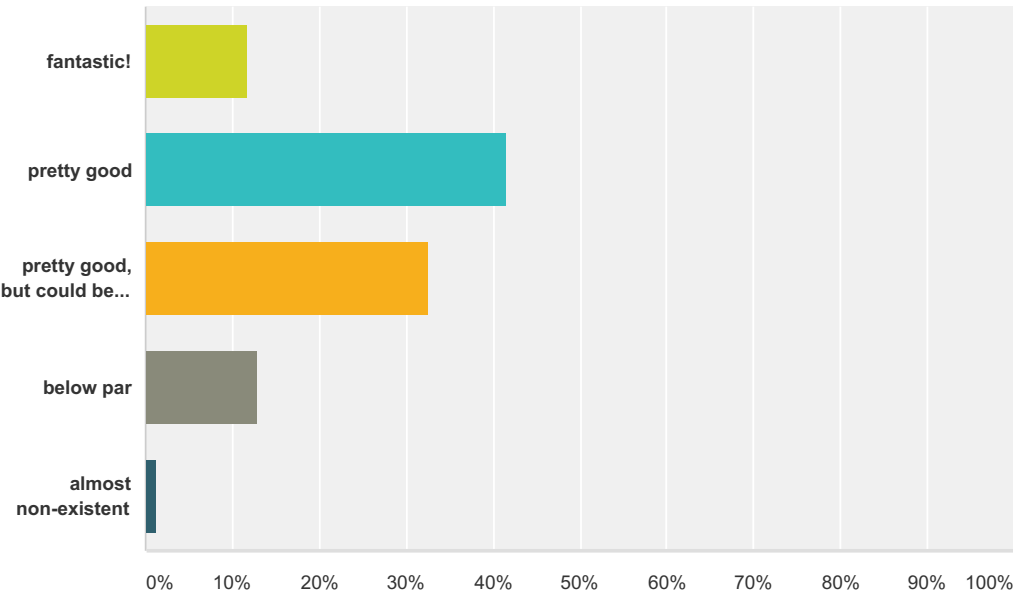

Q4 How would you rate your level of physical activity?

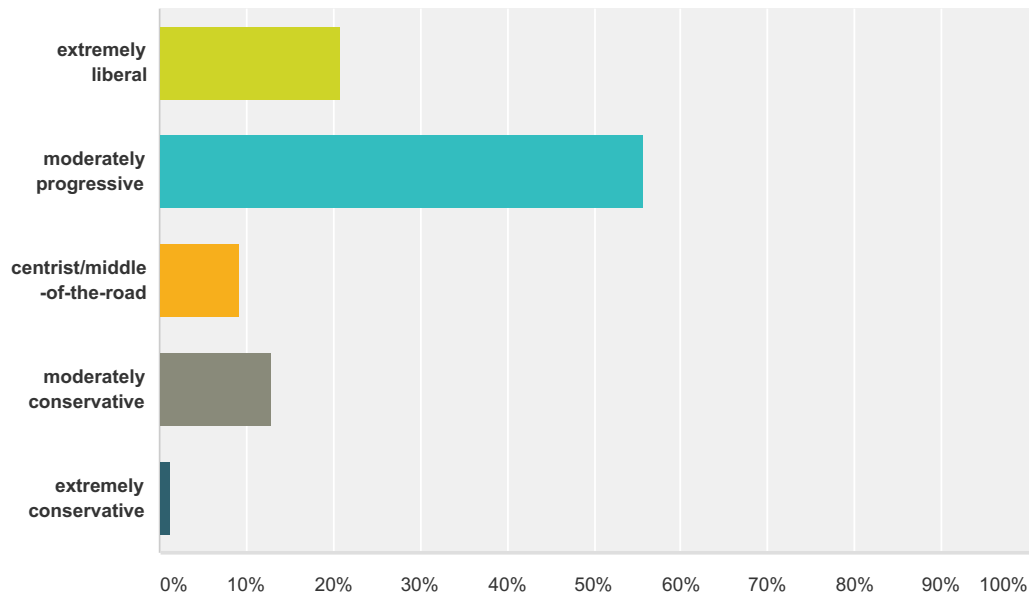

Q5 Where would you place yourself politically?

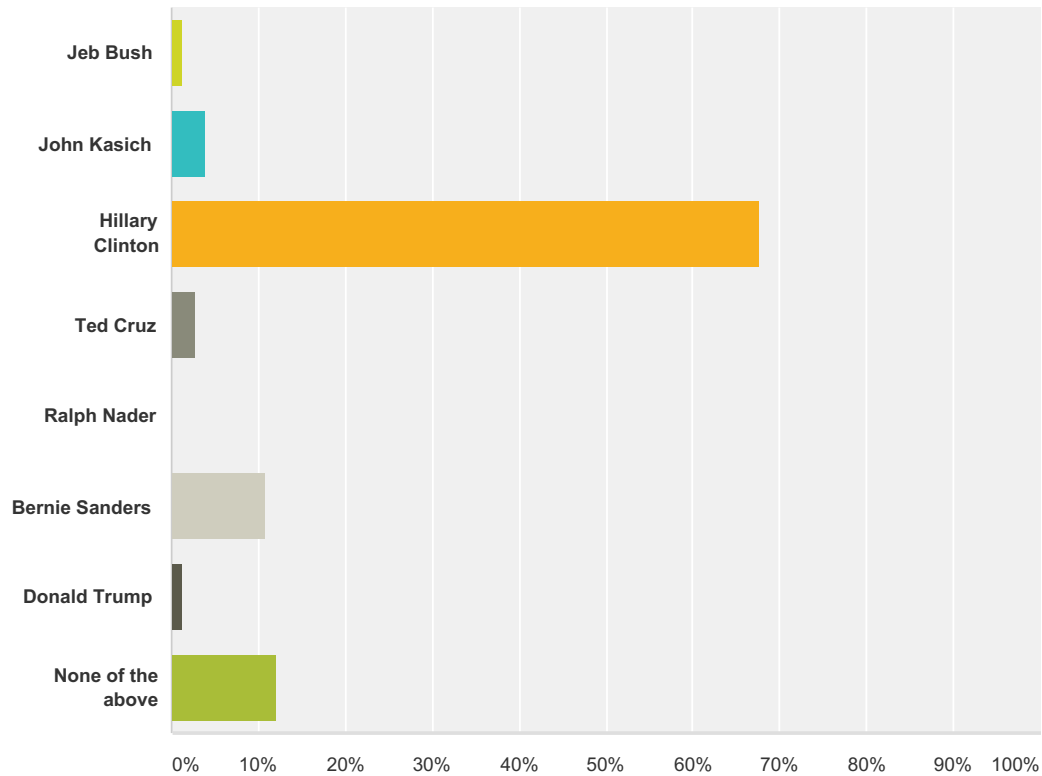

Q6 In the 2016 presidential election, which of the following do you think you will most likely vote for?

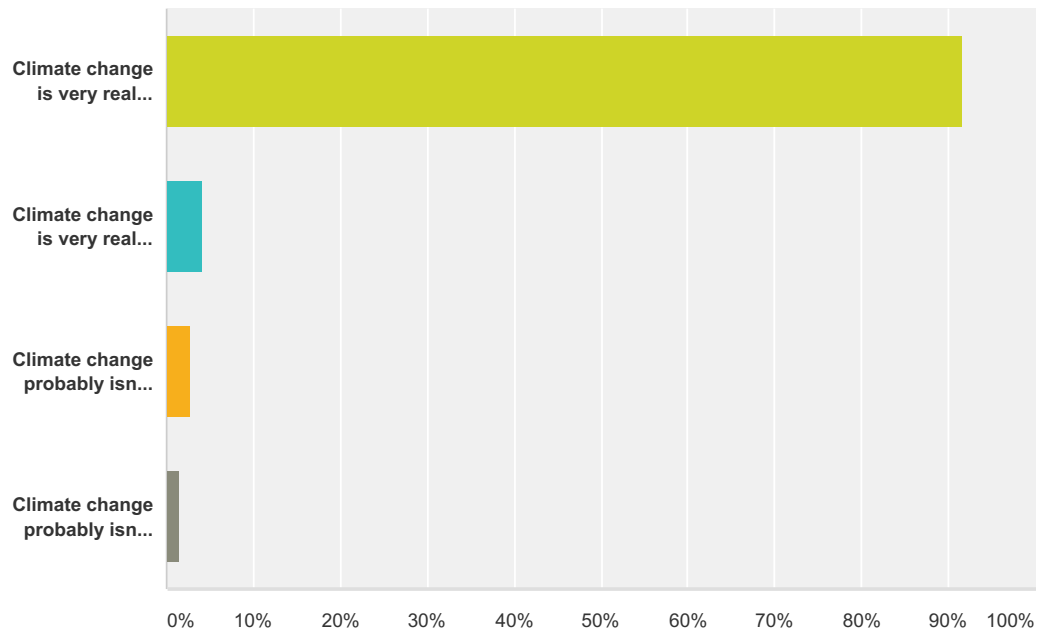

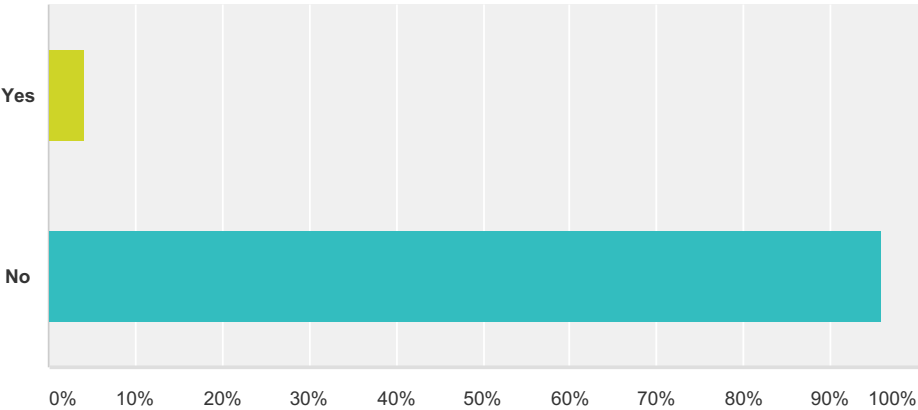

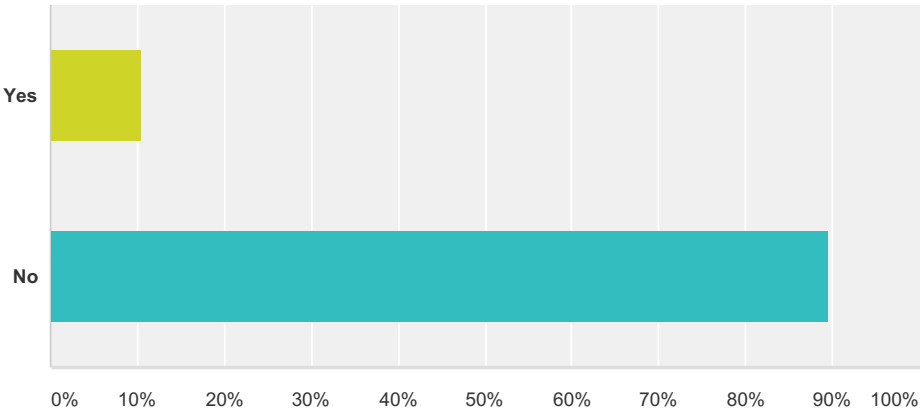

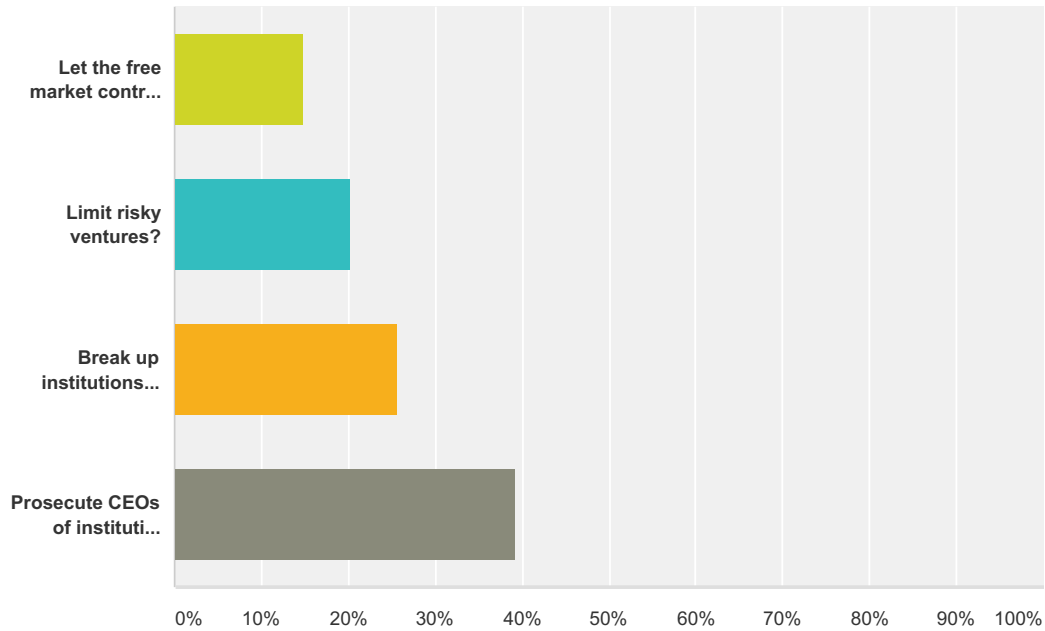

Q10 Re Wall Street, should Congress?

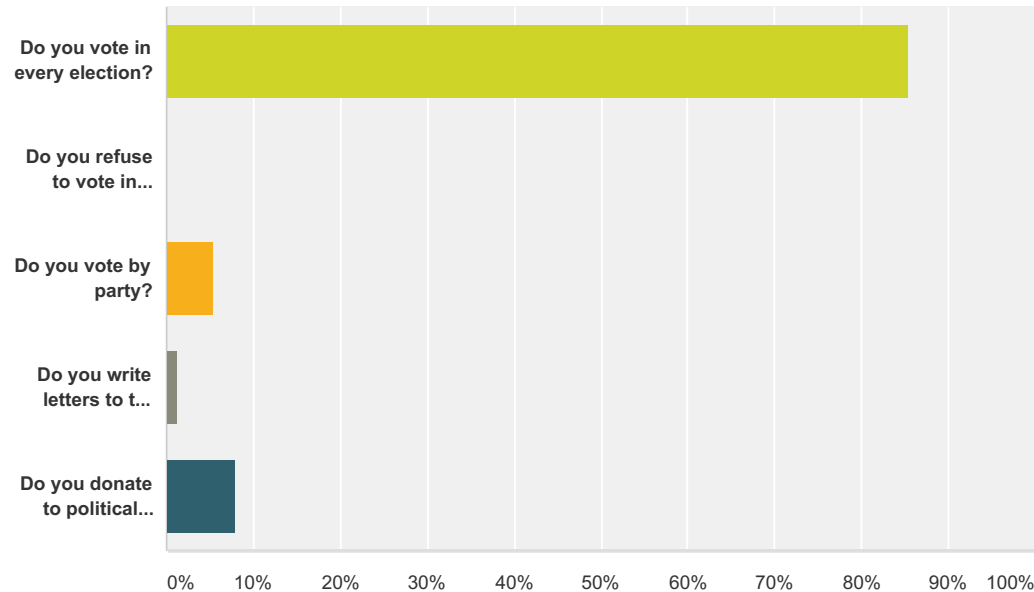

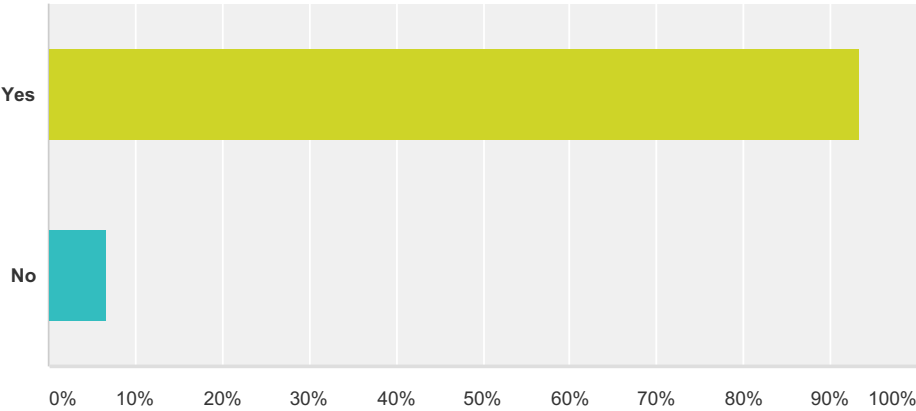

Q12 Do you have a health directive/living will?

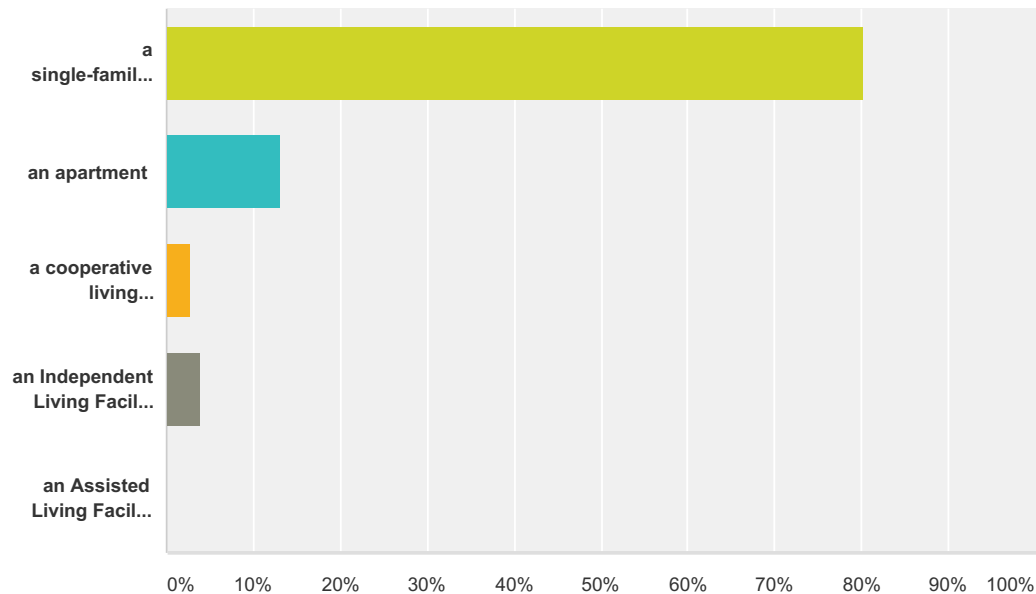

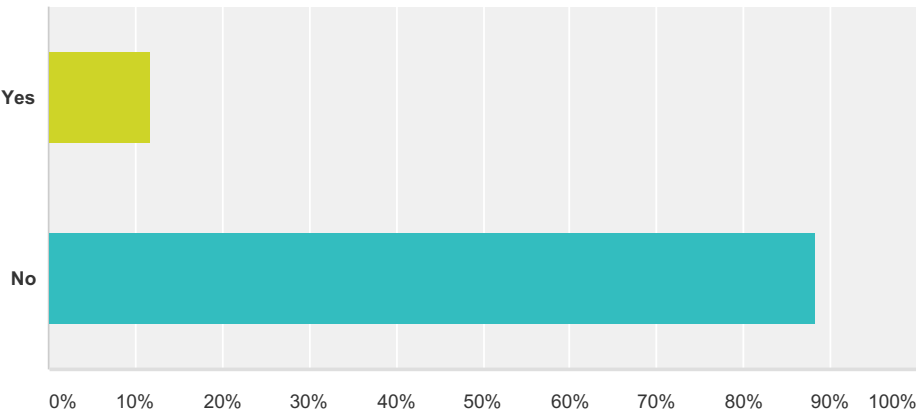

Q14 Have you moved from your home to be near your children?

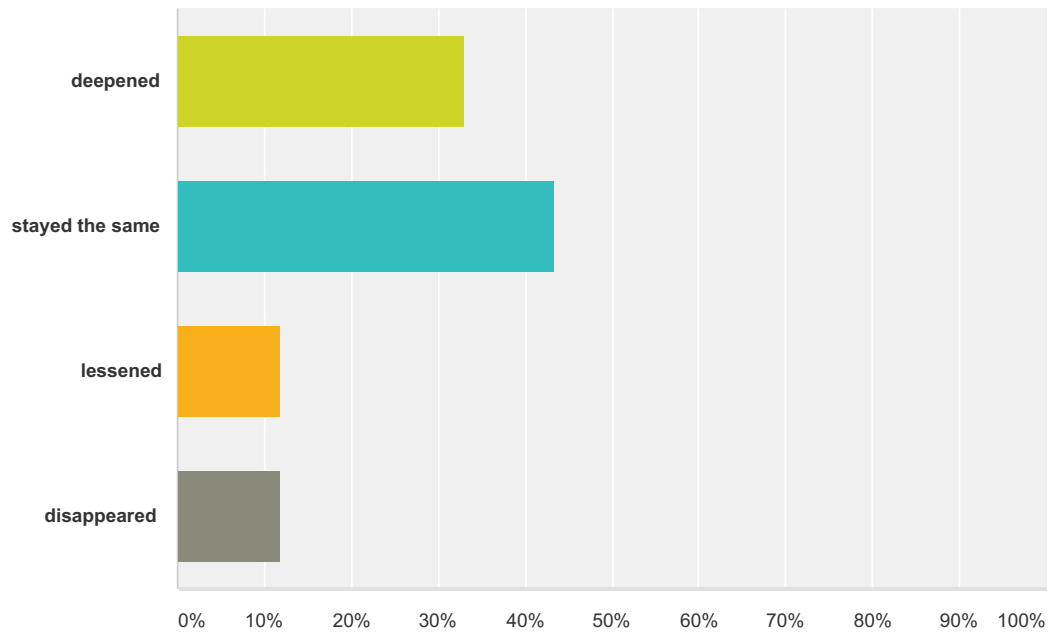

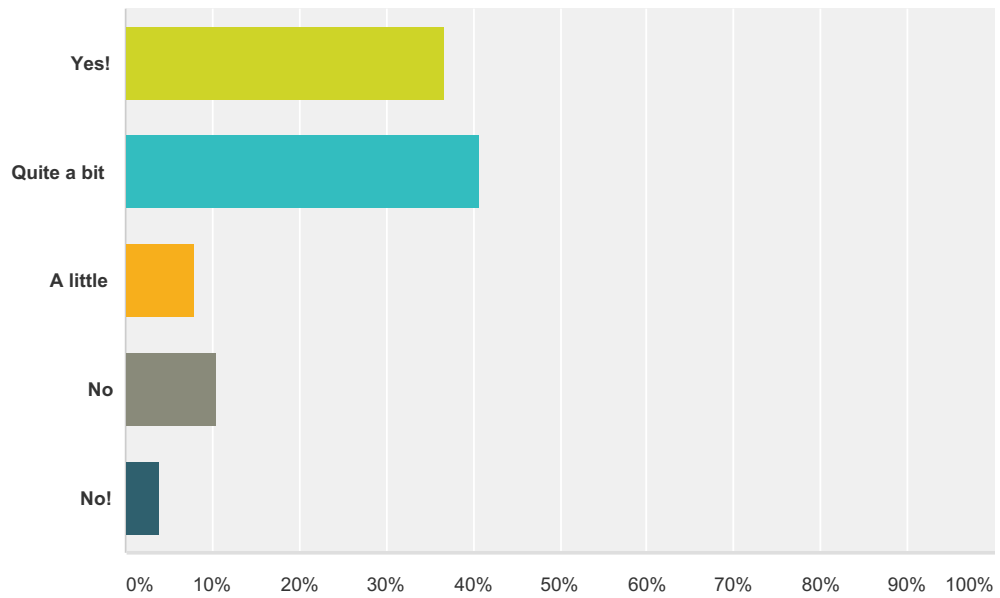
