

"To stream video from your PC or laptop and watch it on your TV, you need to connect an HDMI port from your computer to an HDMI port on your TV set. Do so with an HDMI cable, which you can buy at Walmart or Staples for \$20 to \$30. On your TV set remote, select as signal input the HDMI port that's connected to your computer. On your computer, detect the remote display (your TV set) and set the computer to display to both your computer and the remote display. (You can set up display sharing by right-clicking your desktop, then select Display Resolution. The window should provide an option to detect any remote display that's connected to your computer -- it should detect the TV set. Further controls should allow you to send video to both the computer and the TV set. The audio should automatically follow the video to your TV.)

Navigate the computer as usual to the place you want to stream (e.g., YouTube, Disney, Netflix, etc.) and start watching, as usual. When things get rolling, you may want to switch to "full screen" mode (at the computer) to make the image fill the screen."
