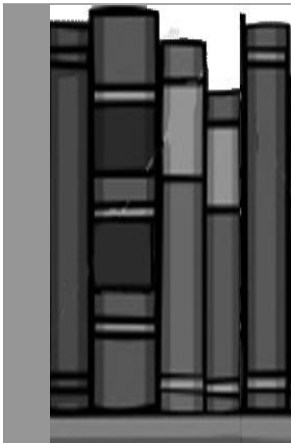
Mini – Reunions
